New Housing Ohio, Inc. COO Accepts Position to Ohio Recovery Housing Board

Cincinnati- Early last month New Housing Ohio, Inc. (NHO) COO Teresa Carrier has accepted a position on the Ohio Recovery Housing Board (ORH). NHO currently has four recovery houses, three in Clinton County and one in Seneca County. With Mrs. Carrier's acceptance to the ORH board, this will allow NHO to help make decisions that could affect recovery housing in Ohio. By being a member, Mrs. Carrier will have access to up to date information regarding recovery housing and resources for NHO recovery housing.

Board members of ORH are elected for 3-year terms and all board members must have one ORH certified recovery housing to be qualified for the position. The ORH board strives to populate itself with members who have housing in each of the four levels of recovery housing, members across the state of Ohio and members who are in long term recovery. The National Association for Recovery Residences established the four levels of recovery residence that offer differing levels of care. The four levels of recovery residences are peer-run recovery housing, sober living homes, supervised residences and service provider residences.

ORH standards are to ensure integrity and quality of recovery housing programs, services and environments for people recovering from substance use. ORH Board, Staff, and Associates recognize that recovery takes time and that residential support has many facets, ranging from residential treatment models to long-term recovery housing. ORH affirms the necessity of a continuum of care to adequately address the total needs of people recovering from addiction.
