New Housing Ohio, Inc. Receives Corporation for Supportive Housing Grant

Cincinnati - New Housing Ohio, Inc. (NHO) received a grant from the Corporation for Supportive Housing (CSH) to provide housing subsidies in 14 counties throughout Ohio. These counties include: Butler, Clermont, Clinton, Erie, Fayette, Greene, Hancock, Huron, Montgomery, Preble, Sandusky, Seneca, Warren and Wyandot. NHO will provide three housing options in these counties; recovery housing, rapid re-housing, and supportive housing. Recovery housing is an alcohol and drug free living environment through which residents are offered peer support and recovery assistance. Rapid re-housing is housing for individuals or families coming from emergency shelters or the streets. Supportive housing is a non-time limited subsidy with more intensive home based supports. NHO will act as the housing broker while partnering with CareSource to obtain services within the housing. The target populations for these housing options are individuals exiting Ohio state prisons who have participated in substance use services.
